In addition to our Monday through Thursday practice schedule, we offer two junior competition formats: **Junior Team Tennis** and **Play Day**.

Junior Team Tennis is a USTA sanctioned event that offers competition seasonally. Spring, Summer, and Fall seasons are offered for players of all levels. Coaches will assign players to the appropriate teams. Players will be issued a USTA number (players that already have one may submit it to their coach during the registration period) for use in registering for Junior Team Tennis.

During the off-season we offer **Play Day**, a fun and low-pressure alternative to Junior Team Tennis. Play Day provides supervised match opportunities for players that want to continue competing or learn during the off-season.
